I wanted to give you an update on current propane prices and the current propane market. Currently, within the US, propane inventories are down as the heating season begins. This is due to a couple of factors; first, the US-based wholesalers and refineries are exporting a large amount of propane overseas and second, refineries within Washington State have to periodically shut down for maintenance. At this time, they do not manufacture more propane, so their inventory is depleted. These factors in the manufacture of propane and the shortage of propane influence the wholesale price per gallon.

Looking forward, it is hard to tell if this trend will continue. I review our pricing weekly and make the appropriate changes. We are a fixed margin based company with no hidden fees attached to our price of propane.

As the market conditions change I will continue to monitor it. Please rest assured that we are working hard daily to provide the best possible price per gallon and the best customer service in the county.
